by Argentinian-Italian artist Lena Becerra



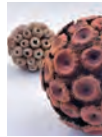

# Theatre Seating Plan

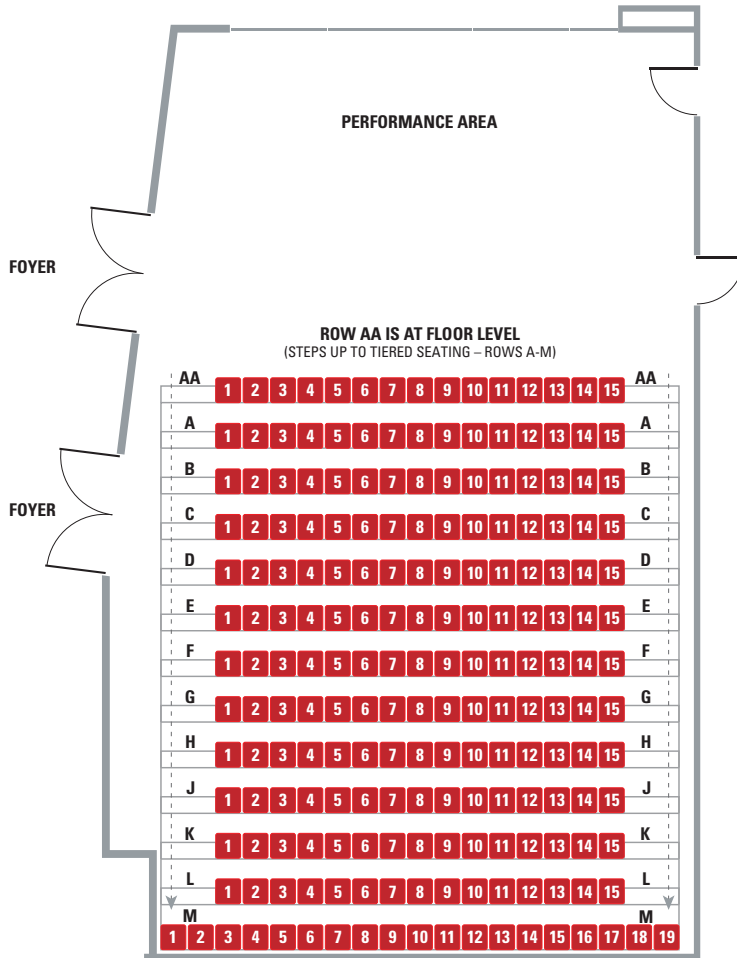
